

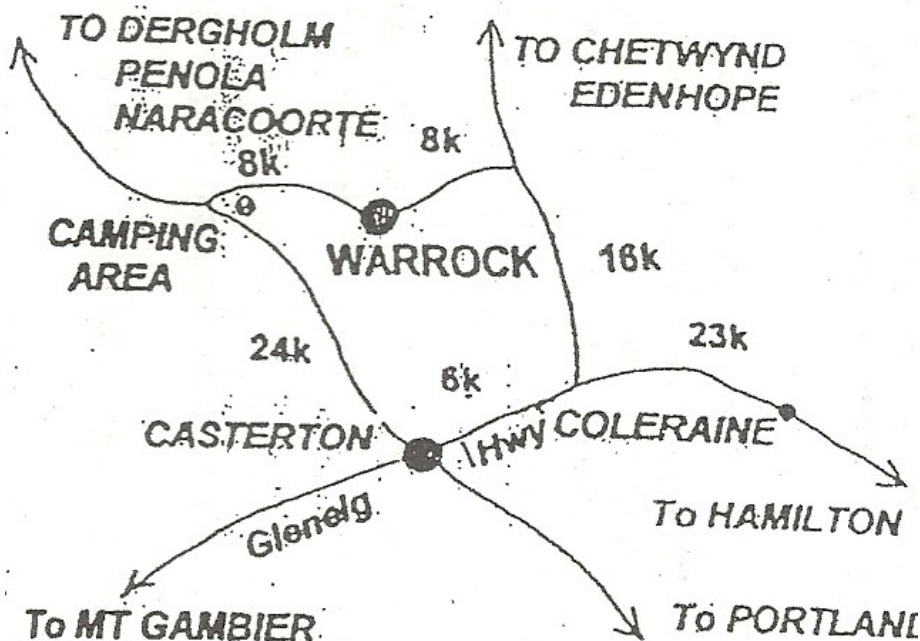
Weekend away at Warrock Homestead

February 18th and 19th 2012

Warrock Homestead, situated 26 km from Casterton on the Casterton Naracoorte Rd, see map. George Robertson, a cabinet maker from Port Glasgow, Scotland, took up the licence to graze this land in 1843. He married his Mary, in June 1852, and as they had no children the property was left to his nephew, George Robertson Patterson. The property is now owned by Carroll and Gavin Larkins. It is amongst the rolling hills and large river red gums and epitomises the richness of the areas pastoral history. It is classified "A" by the National Trust. There are 33 structures around the homestead and contains Victoria's most important collection of Colonial farm buildings dating from the 1840's. These buildings are mostly constructed of sawn timbers and handmade bricks. The sheep property being self sufficient with a blacksmith shop, woolshed, dog kennels, stables, shearers quarters, grain store, bacon house, hay shed, slaughterhouse and a skin shed. Warrock Homestead is home to the famous Kelpie dog breed which was born in the early 1870's and was dubbed kelpie country.
